Longview, Texas is located on Interstate 20, 2 hours east of Dallas and 1 hour west of Shreveport, LA. More than 44 million people live within one day's trucking distance of Longview. This central location in the southern United States means easy and equal access to both coasts, with weather being a virtual non-factor with regard to shipping.

The major markets of Dallas, Houston, San Antonio, Austin, New Orleans, Kansas City, Memphis, Little Rock and Oklahoma City are all within a one-day truck haul.
